

Peabody Historical Society 2017 Miniature Quilt Challenge

"Inspired by Time: Women of Peabody"

Guidelines & Registration Information

Quilters of all levels are invited to participate in the Peabody Historical Society's 2017 miniature quilt challenge: "**Inspired by Time: Women of Peabody.**" Participants will choose one woman from Peabody's history and create a miniature quilt inspired by her story, time period, and designs of that era. Submissions for "Inspired by Time: Women of Peabody" will be exhibited at the Smith Barn on **Saturday, April 1, 2017 from 11-3 pm and Sunday, April 2, 2017 from 12-3 pm**. Category awards will be given to the top entry for each historical woman, including a \$50 cash prize for each category winner. There is no entry fee to participate in this challenge!

Guidelines

1. Entries can be pieced, appliquéd, or embroidered using any kind of fabric.
2. The finished size of the quilt **must be 32" x 32,"** with a 2"-3" sleeve on the back for hanging. *We cannot accept quilts that do not have sleeves.*
3. Entries must be original. Quilts from kits, or quilts created in a classroom setting are not eligible.
6. Entries must be constructed primarily of fabric, comprised of three layers and quilted or tied. Any technique or combination of techniques may be used.
7. Entries can be machine or hand quilted; however, no professional quilting is permitted.
8. A label must be affixed to the back of the quilt that includes the maker's name and address, and the title of the quilt.
9. All entries will be accepted provided space allows and the content/theme of the quilts are suitable for a family audience.

Registration

Please submit a Quilt Challenge Entry Form and one color photo of your quilt either by mail or email to Kelly Daniell no later than **Monday, March 6, 2017**. (*The quilt does not have to be complete.*)

Drop Off

All quilts must be received at the Peabody Historical Society by **Wednesday, March 22, 2017**. Please contact Kelly Daniell to schedule a drop off time.

Quilts may also be mailed to the Peabody Historical Society at 35 Washington Street, Peabody, MA 01960. Please enclose a pre-paid shipping label or a mailing label and a check payable to the Peabody Historical Society for the cost of return shipping.

Pick Up

Quilts may be picked up at the Peabody Historical Society at 35 Washington Street. Please call Kelly Daniell to schedule a pick up time. Mailed entries will be returned within 10 days after the event.
